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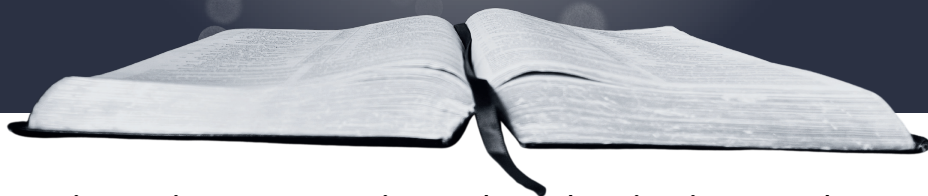

Each attribute also has an "Attribute Card" to fill out and compile into a keepsake booklet (cover included) to remember everything learned about our great God!

Private time with the Lord and personal prayer are two habits worth making an investment in. We pray this little book is a helpful tool in that goal.
