Look upon me, that I may love You.

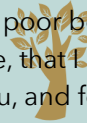


