Who is God?

Day 1: God is the creator. He made all things.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list



Day 2: There is one God. He rules all things.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list

Verse: "Be still, and know that I am God." - Psalm 46:10



Who is God?

Day 3: God is a spirit. He is not like us. We have a body we can see and feel.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list



Day 4: We can not see God, but we can still know Him.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list

Verse: "Be still, and know that I am God." - Psalm 46:10

Day 5: God tells us in the Bible what He is like.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list



Day 6: The things we know about God are called "attributes".

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list



Day 8: Holy means God has no sin at all.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list

Attribute #1: Holy

Day 9: Sin is doing what we want to do and not what God wants us to do.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list



Day 10: God is holy. He can not sin, and He hates all sin.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray for something on your prayer list

Day 11: God made us to be holy too,
but we are not.

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray
for something on your prayer list



Day 12: We sin all the time. We can
not be with a holy God if we sin.
Uh oh!

*Read the verse, listen to the hymn, and pray
for something on your prayer list

Day 13: God will not leave us stuck in sin. He has a plan to save us (that is good!).
